MVG Elementary has a Schoolwide Title I Program

- Title I is a federally funded program.
- The school uses Title I funds to upgrade the entire educational program of the school.
- Title I funds are used to serve ALL children in order to raise academic achievement.
- Title I funds will be used to provide additional assistance to all students who experience difficulties in meeting the State's performance targets.

What is my child doing when being served through the Title I program?

- Students work in small groups to help remediate, tutor, and encourage academic improvement.
- This is done through assisted work time with teacher, activities and games, and progress monitoring.

Assessment:

- Literacy First and Early Star Literacy Tests are used to assess Early Childhood students
- 1st- 6th Grades are assessed with Renaissance Star Reading and Math.
- 3rd-6th Grades are also assessed with state mandated tests (OSTP) given each spring.
- Daily Class performance may also be used to determine students that need extra support.

How can I help my child at home?

- Find time to read with your child
- Play games to practice skills learned at school
- Review graded work with your child
- Help your child study for upcoming tests
- Make conversation about school and learning a priority
- Be consistent and set expectations
- Praise your child often!
- Reach out to the school for additional resources.

- Communication with your child's teacher is crucial in the success of your child's educational experience.
