## EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

SPORT: BASEBALL YEAR: 2021-2022

1. FIRST TO ARRIVE ON THE SCENE PROVIDES FIRST AID.
2. SEND A COACH, MANAGER OR UNINJURED ATHLETE TO NOTIFY THE ATHLETIC TRAINER OR FIRST RESPONDER IF ONE IS AVAILABLE.
3. SEND A COACH, MANAGER OR UNINJURED ATHLETE TO GET THE AED (IF NOT ON-SITE).
4. THE ATHLETIC TRAINER OR FIRST RESPONDER WILL BECOME THE LEADER IF THEY ARE ON-SITE. IF NOT THE HEAD COACH OR SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR WILL BECOME THE LEADER.

LEADER: FIRST RESPONDER OR JEREMY YOUNG (PRIN/AD) OR SAM BELCHER (SUPT.)

LEADER'S ASSISTANT: JEREMY YOUNG (PRIN/AD) OR or SAM BELCHER (SUPT.) OR PETER GONZALEZ

PHONE CALLER: JEREMY YOUNG (PRIN/AD) OR or SAM BELCHER (SUPT.) OR PETER GONZALEZ

- WILL GO TO THE NEAREST PHONE AND ACTIVATE EMS.
- WILL INFORM THE DISPATCHER OF:
  - The nature of injury and age of the athlete.
  - The location of the athlete and directions to the site.
  - Will not hang up until the dispatcher advises him/her to do so.

NEAREST PHONE: HIGH SCHOOL OFFICE OR CELL PHONE

AMBULANCE ENTRANCE: WEST GATES NEAR LEFT FIELD

PERSON TO MEET THE EMS: JEREMY YOUNG OR SAM BELCHER OR PETER GONZALEZ

PERSON TO ACCOMPANY ATHLETE TO HOSPITAL: JEREMY YOUNG (PRIN/AD) or SAM BELCHER (SUPT.)

- WILL RIDE WITH THE ATHLETE IN THE AMBULANCE IN THE EVENT THE PARENTS CANNOT BE LOCATED.
- WILL TAKE THE ATHLETE'S EMERGENCY INFO TO THE HOSPITAL

- Ø It is the Head Coach's responsibility to inform school administrators of the incident if they are not on-site.
- Ø It is the Head Coach's responsibility to inform the injured athlete's parents of the injury immediately.
- Ø It is the Head Coach's responsibility to document the circumstances surrounding the activity and all actions taken.
- Ø EMERGENCY MEDICAL INFO FOR EACH ATHLETE IS TO ACCOMPANY THE TEAM AT ALL TIMES
